### **Web servants Report**

**January 2015**

Hello Family,

Due to the confusion of last cycles missing minutes of November 2012, the web servants have now made all minutes available on the website going back to 2005. They are located under the Regional tab and then Regional service conference and toward the bottom of the page is a link to archived minutes. We are still missing November 2008, July 2010, and November 2012. If anyone has these minutes and email to the web servants we can get them posted.

The meeting list has been updated with all the areas who have turned in the excel spread sheets. There were 9 areas that have turned in so far, if you have not done so and would like to have your areas meeting list updated we have also provided a way to download the excel spread sheets according to areas. These are located under contact us tab and update meeting lists. At the bottom of the page is a link to the spread sheets with the instructions on the format to update them.

We have been in contact with host monster support about the mail forwarding issue and the response was that not all mail servers play well together and we have done everything possible to fix this issue.

Here is part of Host monsters response;

“Unfortunately, several ISPs have chosen to blacklist our e-mail forwarding servers. This has occurred because Host Monster does not initiate any control over email that is incoming to your forwarded email address. Host Monster does not initiate these controls because they often result in legitimate e-mails being filtered. This can result in a large amount of spam that is sent to your forwarded address, which gets delivered to your ISP account (user@comcast.net). The ISP perceives this spam as having originated

from our forwarding server (because it was forwarded from your account), and as a result chooses to block the 'offending' IP address.

Unfortunately, many ISP's have become unbending on this issue (which we can sympathize with, as our company is well aware of the trouble spam e-mails cause), and regrettably there is nothing Host Monster can do to prevent this from happening to our customers if the ISP they are forwarding e-mail to is promoting these measures.

If this is happening to you, we suggest you whitelist the forwarding e-mail account at your ISP level.” The web group has done everything we could do on this issue and apologize for any confusion, and believe that the parties involved in not receiving emails have been corrected.

We are still working on a project to have available on the website each areas boundaries and asc meeting lists. We have completed three areas and would ask that we get the counties that each area covers along with your ASC meeting schedule, the intent is to offer a group that just starts an idea of which area they fall into and where to go if they so choose to participate in ASC's.
